

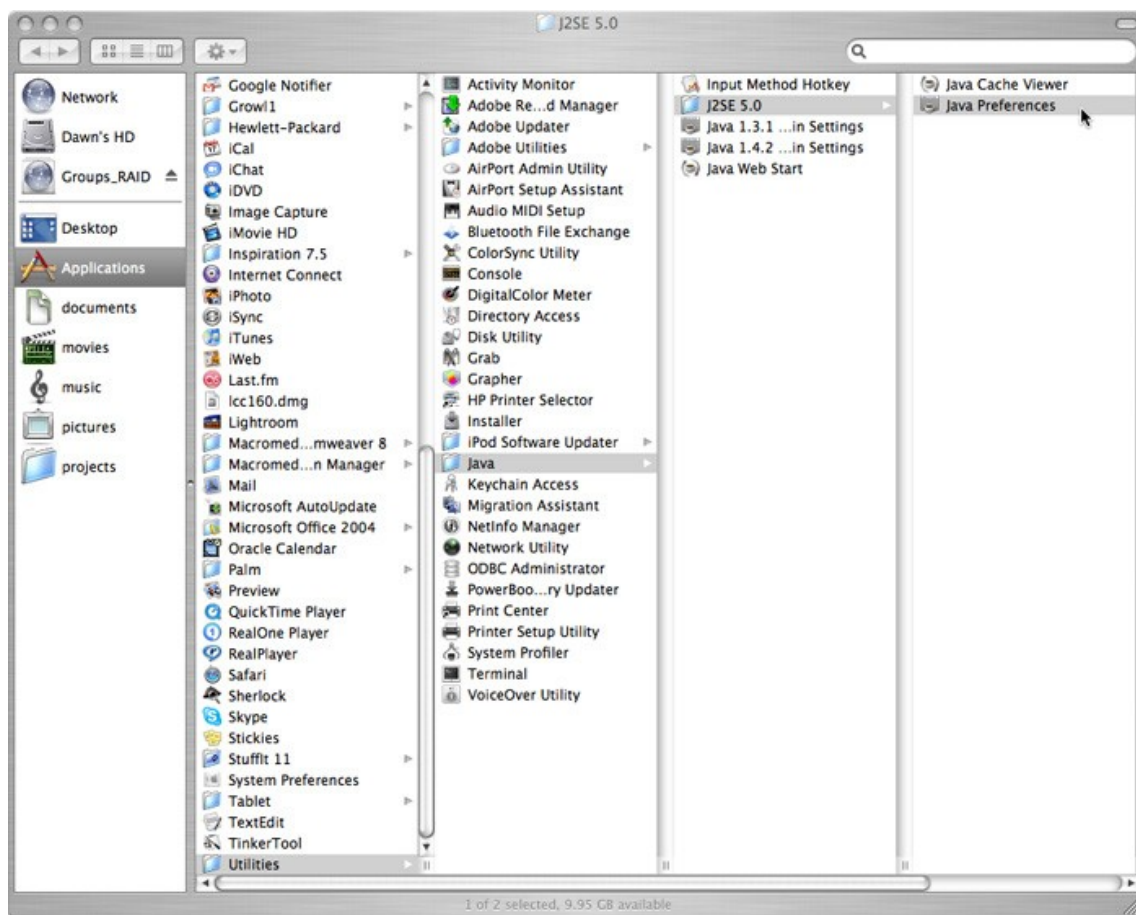
## Clear the Java and Browser Cache for a Mac

*Note: It may be a different depending on version, etc. But in general this is how you do it.*

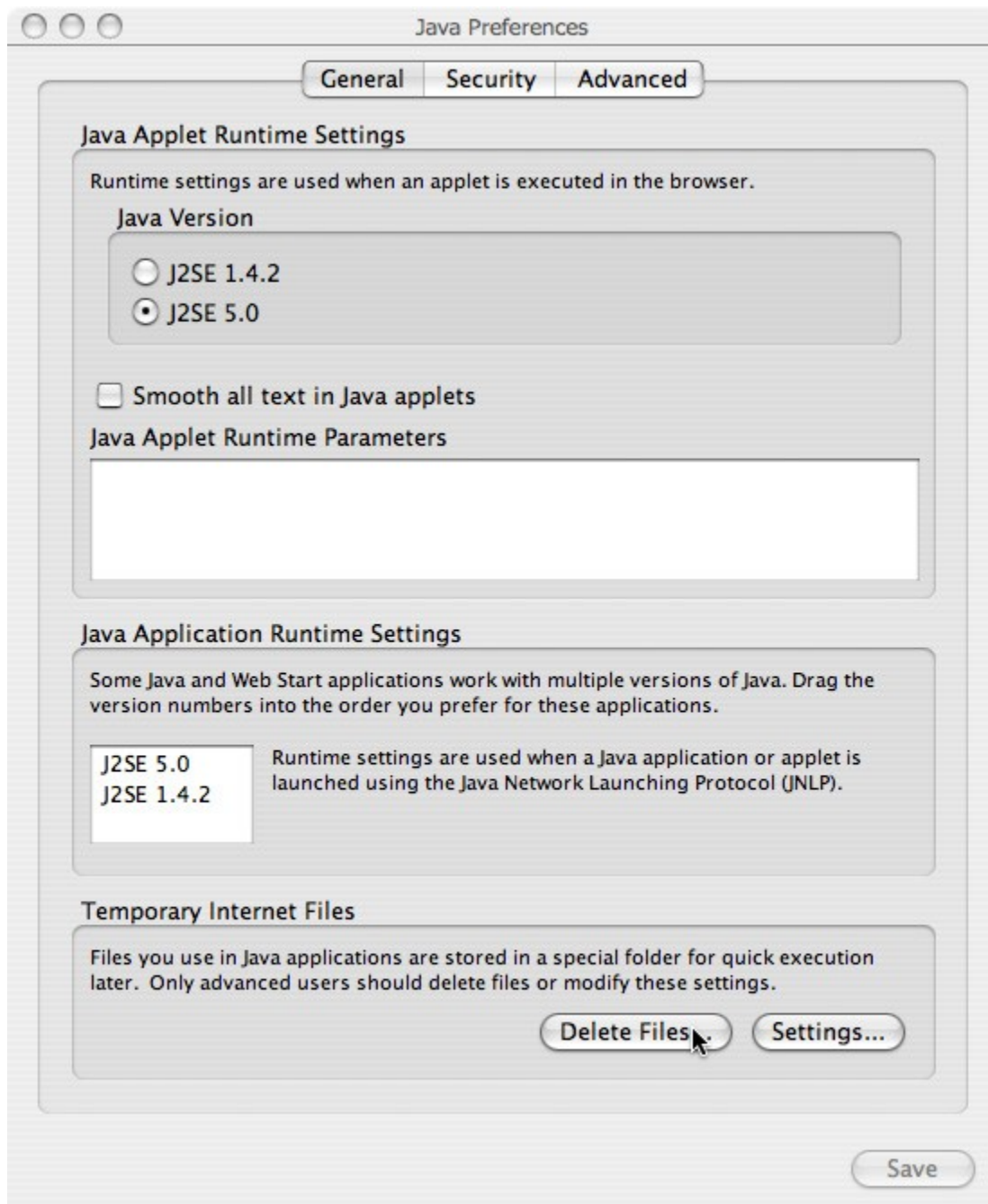
### Java: Clearing the Cache

To empty the cache:

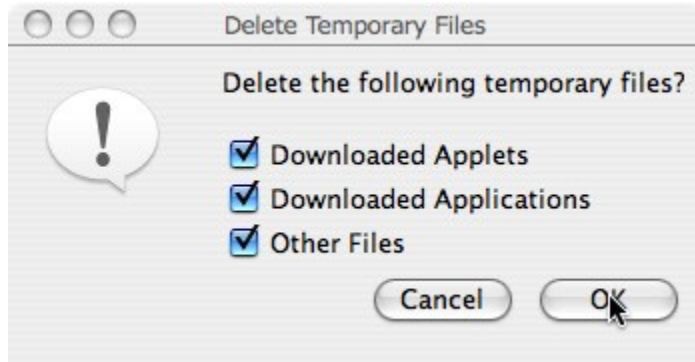
- 1) Open **Finder**.
- 2) Go to Applications.
- 3) Find the Utilities folder.
- 4) Find the Java folder and go to J2SE folder, where you will find **Java Preferences**. Open this file.



The Java Preferences window will open. Select **Delete Files** under the General tab.



The Delete Temporary Files window will open. Make sure all boxes are checked. Select **OK**.



The Java cache has now been cleared.

### Clearing the Browser cache:

#### ***Safari:***

- 1) From the Safari menu, select Reset Safari...
- 2) From the menu, only select Empty the cache and Remove all cookies, then press Reset.

#### ***Firefox:***

- 1) In Firefox, from the Tools menu, select Clear Private Data.
- 2) Make sure Cache and Cookies are checked, and then click Clear Private Data Now.
